


Saori Uda



Lupinus Hill was created on the slope of a hill owned by Hidekatsu Sawaya, a resident of Higashicho in Urakawa. Lupines bloom in early summer, cosmos bloom in autumn, and there are currently more than 100 types of flowers. Looking down below the hill, you can see the Urakawa Port and the city of Urakawa in its entirety. Oromap Observatory is an observatory located along the Tenma Highway connecting Hidaka and Tokachi. The lush pastoral scenery from the observatory is impressive, but the most beautiful of all is the sunset. In spring, many people visit this popular photo spot to view the Obakezakura cherry blossoms. Note that the park is closed during the winter and is only open from late April to late November

Oyakoiwa Fureai Beach is located at a superb location overlooking Oyakoiwa, a rocky outcrop floating in the Pacific Ocean. Since the beach also has a camping site, it is popular on weekends during the summer months. The shared facilities, including cooking facilities and restrooms, are well maintained, and grassy lawns are beautifully maintained, making it a popular spot for families. The beach is easily accessible.

This gravity concrete dam was completed in 1975 for the purpose of flood control. Directly below the embankment is a park with grilling and cooking sites, so that visitors can enjoy barbecues. On the right bank, there is a fish passage newly constructed as part of a water environment improvement project. Mt. Apoi is located near the southern end of the Hidaka Mountains. It is composed of the "Horoman peridotite body", which is believed to be an uplifted exposure of the upper mantle that was several tens of kilometers below the surface when the Hidaka Mountains were formed. Although Mt. Apoi is at a low altitude of 810 m, a wide variety of alpine plants grow there, including Hidakasou and Ezokouzorina, which grow only on Mt. Cape Enrumu (P13)

Cape Enrumu points out toward the Pacific Ocean and forms the eastern shore of the Samani Port. The shoreline is home to the Great herring gull as well as to rock crevice plants such as Ezoinunazuna and Hidakamisebaya. Alpine plants also grow here, and it was the first place where Samani wormwood was discovered. In summer, families enjoy clamming on the shore at the back of the cape.

Mt. Kannon, overlooking Samani Port, was once called "Enzan" (meaning "round mountain") because of its bell shape. The sacred tree is a large oak tree more than 400 years old, which was designated as one of the Memorial Protected Forests in Hokkaido in 1973. The mountain is very close to the city, but it provides a rich natural habitat for wild birds, squirrels, and other animals, It is drivable to the top of the mountain.

The term "takomanma" refers to octopus roe, and this fish cake is made from the roe of a willow octopus. Also the "Toriashi (fried chicken legs)" is recognized as the local best fried chicken by the locals! The area is popular for the azaleas in early summer and for the foliage in the fall. The nearby hydroelectric power plant and Horoman Dam are also part of the scenery that makes Horoman Gorge special.

Seaside Park is known as the home to a colony of Ohbananoenreisou (Trillium camschatcense), and attracts many visitors from both inside and outside of the town. Ohbananoenreisou, a perennial of the lily family, blooms from early to mid-May, and is characterized by its three large white petals. Apparently, it takes more than 10 years for the flowers to bloom, Katakuri and Ezo Primrose can be enjoyed from May to June.

Tokachi Port Marine Fireworks Festival (P25)

The Chinese fireworks seen up close in the night sky and the brilliant underwater fireworks blooming on the surface of the sea are unique to the port's firework festival. Lake Toyoni (P18)

Lake Toyoniko is the only natural lake in Mt. Hidaka Erimo National Park. The lake is surrounded by virgin forest and is known as "Horseshoe Lake" or "Heart Lake" because the surface of the lake looks like a horseshoe or a heart. Around the lake, which has a circumference of about 1 km, there is also a habitat for the Ezonaki Usagi, which is said to be a survivor of the Ice Age. Hokkaido has protected it as the Lake Toyoniko Bird and Wildlife Sanctuary.

Kelp Fishing (P19)

The rich sea in Frimo is home to a thriving fishery industry which includes salmon, trout and others. Kelp fishing plays a central role in the industry. From early summer to late fall, one-third of the Erimo households are involved in kelp fishing. The amount of fish harvested annually is as high as 10,000 tons, and most of it is shipped to the Kansai region.

Shoya Sakura Park offers a panoramic view of the Shoya Fishing Port and cherry blossoms. It is widely known as one of the best cherry blossom viewing sites. Every year, around the middle of May, many visitors come to enjoy these cherry blossoms. The Ezo Yamazakura cherry tree, estimated to be 300 years old, is located at the back of the park. It is called "husband and wife cherry trees" because it was originally two cherry trees, which supported each other and eventually became one large tree.

In mid-May, the best time to view Ezo-vamatsutsuii (azaleas), about 12.000 of them bloom at once, and the entire park is covered in red flowers. The Hiroo Azalea Festival is usually held in early June when the azaleas are in full bloom in red, welcoming many

Tokachi Shrine is the oldest shrine in Tokachi, and was founded around the 1600s. The shrine houses the treasure "Wood Carving of the Toezo Shindo Ki (New Road to East Ezo)" by Shigezo Kondo, an explorer. The carving is designated as cultural property of the Hokkaido government. In spring, the Ezo-Yamazakura cherry trees bloom majestically, making it a popular spot for cherry blossom lovers. Every year, cherry blossoms are illuminated at night in the park in front of Tokachi Shrine.
